Nikki Oakley, Local Service Manager for Skelton Court, said: "I'm so proud of my team for everything they've achieved, especially after all they and the residents have been through with Covid. It was a big surprise for us to even be nominated for a Learning Disability and Autism award, so to be nominated for a Great British Care Award as well is really the icing on the cake."
