Set in Bridlington, on the East Yorkshire coast, Montague House has nine one-bedroom apartments. We provide support for young adults aged 16-24 who are homeless, at risk of homelessness or are survivors of domestic abuse, offering a move-on service to assist them in living independently.

At Sanctuary Supported Living we provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support to help people across England on their pathways for independence.

We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.

Nine part-furnished one-bedroom apartments and one emergency room, spread across three floors.



Location

The heart of Bridlington, near to the seafront, town centre amenities, East Riding College and public transport connections.



Communal areas

A lounge, kitchen, shower room and garden.

We can provide assistive technology for extra safety and reassurance, which can be purchased at additional cost.



Safety and security

On-site office, security personnel presence overnight, CCTV and a secure door access system all help to ensure residents' safety and security.

All apartments are let on a licence agreement.

Support

Our highly-trained staff work closely with residents to create a personalised support plan using the Home Star model, designed to help them reach their goals and maximise their independence.

Staff are on-site during office hours, giving residents peace of mind that support is on-hand. There is an overnight concierge service seven days a week and an out-of-hours telephone service for any additional support needs.

We support residents to manage and improve their personal safety and improve social, emotional and mental wellbeing.

Tailored support, advice and assistance includes:

- › Daily living skills
- › Maintaining a tenancy
- › Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- › Cooking, cleaning and shopping
- › Dealing with correspondence
- › Signposting and accessing other services
- › Accessing education, training and employment
- › Planning a successful move-on
- › Preventing homelessness
- › Managing rent and rent arrears

How to apply and eligibility

To apply directly, please contact us for an application form. We also accept referrals from various local support agencies.

Please note that all support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

To be eligible for a place at Montague House, applicants must:

- › Be aged 18 to 24
- › Be homeless, at risk of becoming homeless or a survivor of domestic abuse
- › Have a local connection to the East Riding of Yorkshire (unless they are a survivor of domestic abuse)

Residents can purchase additional telecare technology for an enhanced sense of confidence and safety at home and in their community.
