About Sanctuary Supported Living

At Sanctuary Supported Living we provide supported housing, move-on accommodation, CQC registered services and floating support to help people across England on their pathways for independence.

We specialise in services for young people, homeless families and individuals, people with physical disabilities, learning disabilities and people with mental health needs.



Accommodation



Accommodation type

Spread over five floors, there are 14 unfurnished apartments, each with a single-occupancy bedroom, spacious living room, en-suite wet room and kitchen, with level access throughout. There is a lift to all floors.



Communal WiFi and overhead hoist system installed in each apartment to support independence. Assistive technology, such as bed sensors, can be purchased at an additional cost.



Within walking distance of Streatham Common, shops, restaurants, and leisure facilities, as well as transport links for easy access to all of London's top attractions.



Safety and security

Staff are on-site 24/7, supported by CCTV, a secure door access system, and a bespoke emergency call system to ensure residents' safety and security.



Communal areas

A laundry room, kitchen, shared lounge and dining area. There is also a garden, and a secure car park for visitors.



All apartments are let on assured shorthold tenancy agreement.

Care and Support

Using our Digital Social Care Records system, our teams work closely with residents to create personalised care and support plans. We can provide care and support, including personal care, depending on individual needs.

Staff are on-site 24 hours a day, and a bespoke emergency call system ensures that support is always on hand, providing peace of mind.

We work closely with local healthcare professionals, such as district nurses, to achieve the best outcomes for residents with changing needs, supporting them to live independently while ensuring they feel safe.

Tailored care, support, and assistance includes:

- Maintaining a tenancy, managing rent
- Daily living skills
- Managing finances (budgeting and benefits)
- Managing personal care and medication
- > Socialising and community involvement
- Maintaining health, safety and security
- > Accessing education, training and employment
- Managing nutrition and hydration needs
- Signposting and accessing other services
- Positive behaviour management

How to apply and eligibility

To apply, please contact us to ask for an application form. We also accept referrals from Lambeth Council and any other London borough.

All support needs will be assessed before an application is accepted.

To be eligible for a place at St John's House, applicants must:

- Be aged 18 or over
- Have a physical disability and require 32 hours of support per week

Residents can purchase additional telecare technology for an enhanced sense of confidence and safety at home and in their community.
