Free Wi-Fi in communal areas. An integrated emergency pull cord alarm system is installed throughout, with personal pendant alarms available if required. Bed sensors and door sensors also help to maintain independence.

Care and Support

Our expert staff are available on-site during various hours throughout the day to suit residents' needs. We provide residential care and support, including personal care, depending on individual needs.

Residents can purchase additional telecare technology for an enhanced sense of confidence and safety at home and in their community.
